All the information inserted in this publication will be susceptible of change for rules variations imposed by superior Organisms that had to subsequently rise up after the date of publication or if dictated by necessity .

RULES

The competition's rules is the one approved by the Italian Cycling Federation for the **Circuito Italiano BMX 2018 series**; you can read it at the following link (sorry but is in Italian language only): <http://bmx.feder ciclismo.it/it/infopage/calendario-e-regolamento-2018/8bff3324-ba00-4689-bd23-be6e5efcd054/>

All registered riders have to do 3 scrambled qualification motos to qualify for the next stage of the event. The groups for these qualification motos will be composed on a random selection of confirmed riders and will be randomly scrambled into moto groups every run. (according to Article 6.1.033 of UCI rules).

Gate selection order for run 1 – 2 – 3 will be randomly generated by the computer.

Men Elite will race against Men Junior in an Open class, as well Women Elite with Women Junior; the final results will be split in two separate classes based on the results summary. Riders will be awarded with the prize money that correspond with the place in the separate results.

For all the other race parameters the competition will be run under the UCI 2018 cycling regulations (part 6 BMX) also for Master/Challenge/Cruiser categories.

The Challenge classes under 12 years will compete merged as follow (the final classification will be separated for each years but not for the gender):

- boys/girls 7 - 8 years - boys/girls 9 - 10 years - boys/girls 11 - 12 years

If there are less than 5 riders confirmed in the girls 13/14 and girls 15/16 they will be combined with the corresponding male category, with final results and prize money not separated.

The races are open to all riders from any country in Championship and Challenge classes from 7 years and over; all riders (Challenge and Championship) must hold a national license issued by an UCI affiliated Federation.

The allowed categories are the following:

BMX – 20" wheels:

boys/girls 7/8 years;
boys/girls 9/10 years;
boys/girls 11/12 years;
boys/girls 13/14 years;
boys/girls 15/16 years;
Master 17+ M/W;
Junior M/W;
Elite M/W.

Cruiser – 24" wheels:

boys 13/14 years;
boys 15/16 years;
master 17 +.

NUMBER PLATES

Every Italian riders must use the Agressive number plates furnished by the Italian Cycling Federation (see sample on appendix "A") without any modification; the bikes must be equipped also with lateral number plates for the photofinish. Only foreign riders could use their personal frontal and lateral number plates.

CLOTHING AND SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

Riders of all category must follow what International rules says about race clothing and safety equipment; among the other things:

- Only Elite riders who received a permanent career number through the UCI or Elite riders with a world number 1-8 , may print a permanent career number or world number 1-8 on the back of the jersey. Riders without a UCI permanent career number can not print a number on the back of their jersey (permanent career numbers list can be read on Internet at the following link: <http://www.uci.ch/bmx/documents/>).
- Short pants made of tear-resistant material are permitted if used together with knee and shin protection with a rigid surface that extends from the knee protection to fully cover the shin, or to just above the ankle.
- Jeans/denim pants are not permitted.
- Use of videocameras are not permitted during practice, qualifying rounds and finals.

CLIPLESS PEDALS:

The use of interlocking pedal-cleat systems is allowed for categories 13 years and over.



RIDERS REGISTRATION

Before Thursday 15 march at 24,00

The registration open saturday February 3rd 2018 at 8,00 a.m.

The deadline is fixed Thursday 15 march at 24,00; the registration's request will be made with the dedicated entry-form that will be downloadable from the following website:

All riders with non - Italian license must send together with the Entry Form the permission to compete abroad issued by their National Cycling Federation; the original paper version must be delivered at license control.

REGISTRATION FEES

REGISTRATION CONTROL and TEAM MANAGER'S MEETING

License control will be held saturday 17 march from 12,00 to 14,00 and is valid for both racedays; sunday 18 march the license control is possible for riders who compete only in sunday's race, and is open from 8,00 to 9,00.

Team manager meeting will be held saturday 17 march at 14,30 and sunday 18 march alle ore 9,30. At the end of the meeting will be distributed the PASS for Team Manager / Crew.

PAY ATTENTION: the meeting is mandatory for all the Teams/Clubs; the Teams Managers that do not take part in the meeting will not be distributed any PASS and access to the track and/or staging area will be forbidden, as established by the Italian Cycling Federation's RTF - Annex 1 - Article. 1.17.



PRIZE MONEY

The prize money are established by the Italian Cycling Federation and are listed as follow (amounts in Euro); they will be paid immediately after the award ceremony. Prize money non collected directly after the ceremony will not be paid out afterwards.

TEAM MANAGER'S AREA

The organization will provide ID cards / passes for two person (Team Manager and assistant) for each National, Trade or Club Team entering the race. The Team Manager's area is located inside the track between the first and second straight line (see the venue map on page 10). **No access to other place inside the track is allowed.**

TEAM AREA

In the straight paved with tarmac next to the starting line will be placed the gazebos for Team, in the red edged spaces on the attached plan (see venue map at page 10). For a better utilization of this space is recommended that each Team did advance request assignment of the space sending an e-mail message to info@bmxbesnate.it specifying the number and size of the gazebo, trying to adapt the space required for the actual number of registered riders with the following rules:

- Team with less than 5 riders: one space of mt.3,00 x 3,00;
- Team with riders between 6 and 10; one space of mt.6,00 x 3,00;
- Team with more than 10 riders: two space of mt. 3,00 x 6,00.

The allocation of spaces will be made according to the reservation order; additional spaces for other gazebos will be made available in other areas of the circuit.

PARKING

All the cars must be left outside the track's fence (purple line in venue map), in the dedicated yellow area. No motor vehicles will be allowed inside the track, with the exception of ambulance and expositor's cars.

The camping car's parking will be located at 200 meters from the track (see the air image in this page); the campsite has one bathroom and will be opened from Friday 16 march at 18,00. The parking for mobile homes and caravans will be free of charge; the area will be not fenced and not guarded.

The organization recommends to park in orderly manner and not to leave garbage on the campsite at the end of the competition.

Please note that inside the fenced area of the gym will not be allowed campers, tents and is forbidden sleep or stay overnight with other fixed or mobile solution of any kind, due to a specific order issued by Local Police.

All the people who don't stay in hotel must sleep exclusively in the market area specifically designed for this purpose.



CATERING

During the whole race's days there will be a bar service where you can buy hot and cold food and drink.

BATHROOM

The bathroom inside the gym will be opened Saturday from 12,00 until 18,30 and Sunday from 8,00 until 15,30; during the night they will be closed. It's strictly forbidden to go inside the playfield of the gym.

Guide to separate waste collection

For a more "eco-sustainable" approach, we ask all the participants to not abandon waste in the areas affected by the event (including the car parks and the camping area) and to divide them in the correct way, as described below:

- paper and cardboard in white rigid plastic containers;
- clean plastic in the yellow bags;
- glass and aluminum cans in the green rigid plastic containers;
- undifferentiated waste in the pink/purple bags.

The containers will be located near the bar, where plastic bags will also be distributed free of charge. In the image below you will find a descriptive guide to the different types of waste that can be transferred. All the Team are asked to raise awareness among their Associates on this specific request.

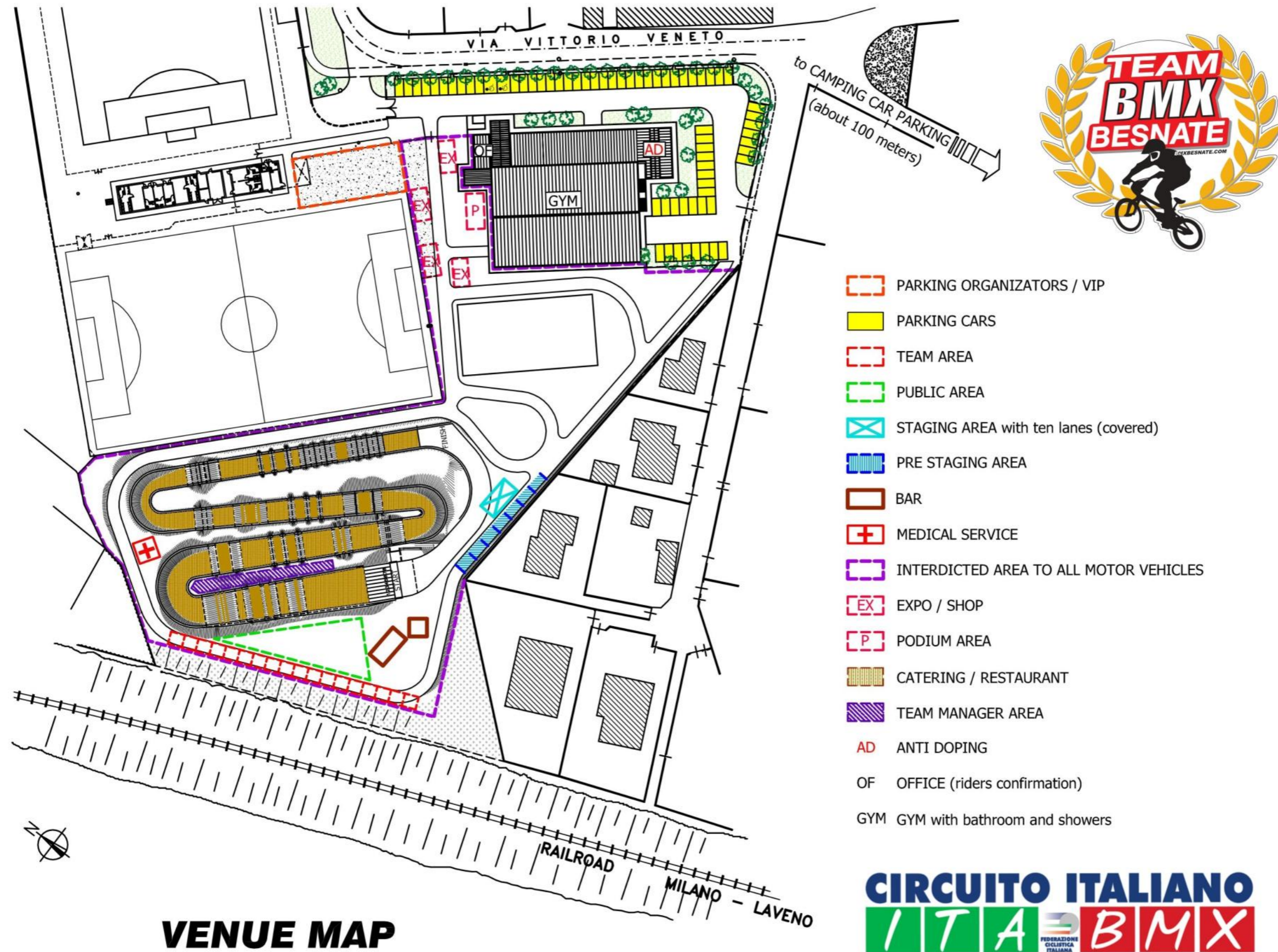
